1. **Da Luca Prosecco, Italy** £26.00  
*Pear and peach fruit on a lively, yet soft and generous palate*
2. **Da Luca Rosato Spumante, Italy** £25.00  
*Fresh and vibrant raspberry and strawberry scented fizz made from a blend of Merlot and Raboso*
3. **Greyfriars Cuvée Brut, England** £42.00  
*A classic blend of the three Champagne grapes, Chardonnay, Pino Noir and Pinot Meunier, Grown in Surrey. Dry, elegant with a refreshing palate and fine mousse.*
4. **Sauvion Crémant de Loire, Brut, France** £38.00  
*Rich and frothy with ripe up-frot flavours of peach and white-fleshed fruit*
5. **Bouché Père et Fils Cuvée Réserve Brut, France** £48.00  
*A ripe, biscuity Champagne with a fine mousse and a long elegant finish*
6. **Tattinger Brut Réserve, France** £110.00  
*The intensely fragrant character, subtle biscuity complexity and superb elegance is due to a Predominance of Chardonnay in the blend*
7. **Tattinger Prestige Brut Rosé, France** £90.00  
*Champagne but pink, a hint of red gives a burst of red berries on the nose and palate*

## Dry, Delicate and Light Whites

8. **Solstice Pinot Grigio delle Venezia, Italy** £23.00  
*Fresh, crisp with subtle notes of citrus and pear fruit*
9. **Gavi Ca' Bianca, Italy** £30.00  
*White flower and green fruit aromas, with a touch of honey and refreshing minerality on the palate*
10. **Muscadet de Sèvre et Maine Sur Lie, France** £29.00  
*Appetising, crisp acidity and apple fruit, the palate is bone-dry and light*
11. **Sancerre, Les Collinettes, Joseph Mellot, France** £46.00  
*Stylish and crisp aromas of gooseberries and powerful fruit flavours, linked with a clean Finish, from one of the finest and most dynamic producers*

## Dry, Herbaceous and Aromatic Whites

12. **Tekena Sauvignon Blanc, Central Velly, Chile** £23.00  
*Refreshing, with citrus and tropical fruit flavours and a crisp finish*
13. **Southern Rivers Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand** £26.00  
*Fresh and crisp with classic characters of gooseberry and tropical flavours*
14. **Molino a Vento Organic Grillo Sicilia, Italy** £28.00  
*A natural bouquet with typical fruity and floral notes of Sicilian citrus combined with great balance and acidity. This wine is 100% organic*
15. **Analivia, Verdejo Rueda, Pagos del Rey, Spain** £28.00  
*With its lemon-yellow colour, this wine exhibits complex aromas of ripe soft peach and pear fruit, lemon and floral hints. Unoaked, the palate is quite rich on the finish with notes of white-fruit*

16. Short Mile Bay Chardonnay, S.E. Australia £21.00  
*Unoaked, a tropical fruit flavoured wine with notes of Spring blossom and honey*
17. William Hardy Chardonnay, Limestone Coast, Australia £26.00  
*Shows aromas of melon and white peach, fresh and lively palate with rich flavours of Peach, lemon zest and spice*
18. Vine Trail Viognier, Rapel Valley, Chile £23.00  
*Peach, apricot and white blossom, balanced with a citrus acidity on the palate*
19. Picpoul de Pinet, Les Girelles, Jean-Luc Colombo, France £29.00  
*A rich, mouth-filling wine with notes of fresh flowers, melon and ripe summer stone fruit*

## Dry, Delicate and Floral Rosé

20. Marchesi Ervani Pinot Grigio Rosato, Pavia, Italy £23.00  
*Pinky colour with copper highlights and a bouquet of wild flowers and vanilla. Delicate strawberry fruit*
21. Coteaux varois en Provence Rose, Reflet, Estandon. France £29.00  
*Notes of citrus and pink grapefruit flesh on the nose. Silky and smooth on the palate with A lovely balance between the wine's freshness and it's silky body*

## Rich, Fruity Rosé with a Kiss of Sugar

22. Short Mile Bay Rosé, S E Australia £21.00  
*Strawberry and red cherry, backed by citrus notes.*
23. Lavender Hill White Zinfandel, California, USA £23.00  
*Medium dry, rather than the usual medium-sweet versions available, shows plenty of watermelon Strawberry and redcurrant fruit.*

## Fruit led Lighter Reds

24. Rare Vineyards Pinot Noir, Vin de France £23.00  
*From the foothills of the Pyrenees, soft, lightly oaked cherries and blueberries with a Hint of spice.*
25. Fleurie, Pascal Clément, France £36.00  
*The name Fleurie aptly describes the fresh, floral style of the wine*
26. Short Mile Bay Shiraz, S E Australia £21.00  
*Rich berry fruit on the palate and a pinch of pepper spice so typical of Shiraz*
27. Côtes du Rhône, Les Abeilles Rough, Jean-Luc Colombo, France £29.00  
*Fresh and silky on the palate, the aromas of small red fruits follow through, prolonged by Notes of liquorice and spice.*

## Fuller-Bodied, Spicy Reds

28. The Guv'nor, Felix Solis. Spain £24.00  
*Shows plenty of rich, ripe sweet red and dark fruit flavours and a juicy finish*
29. Don Jacobo Rioja Crianza, Viticultura Ecologica, Organic Bodegas Corral, Spain £28.00  
*Red and black fruit, dairy and vanilla on the nose: in the mouth has soft tannins and g  
Good acidity, fruity and slightly spiced, hints of new oak barrel and a lingering finish*
30. Tekena Merlot, Central Valley, Chile £23.00  
*Full-driven, raspberry and blueberry fruit leading to a soft finish*
31. Château Montcabrier, Bordeaux Supérieur, France £26.00  
*A good quality wine that provides classic claret flavours. The blend is dominated by Merlot, Cabernet Franc making up most of the balance*

## Rich, Elegant, Complex Reds

32. Vine Trail Malbec, Rapel Valley, Chile £23.00  
*Delicious, ripe red and black fruit flavours and a touch of spice*
33. Salentein Barrel Selection Malbec, Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina £35.00  
*Notes of ripe blackberry and redcurrant, with subtle hints of violet. The silky  
Palate offers a crisp, balance backed by vanilla on the lingering finish.*
34. Tenute Piccini "Antica Cinta" Chianti, Italy £23.00  
*Bright, ruby-red wine with an intense and persistent fragrance of mature red fruit.*
35. Prinus Carmenère, Colchagua Valley, Chile £36.00  
*Richly flavoured, plum and blackberry mingling with exotic spice and dried fig.*

## Dessert Wine

36. Errázuriz Late Harvest Sauvignon Blanc, Casablanca, Chile (37.5cl) £26.00  
*Made with grapes picked very late in the season influenced significantly by Botrytis  
Which has concentrated the sugars, acids and flavours in the grapes to create a pleasing  
Character that recalls honey, raisins, and dried apricots.*
